Historical Background

"Despite the advantageous terrain of the Carthaginian camp, Himilco led his army out to meet Agathocles as he advanced. Agathocles massed his crack mercenaries in the center with Libyan troops holding the wings. The Carthaginians focused their attacks on the Greeks and other mercenaries, recognizing that the Libyans might soon defect anyway. Agathocles' men nearly ruptured the Punic center, but Himilco's men held and ultimately overcame the Greeks. After leaving over 3000 dead and being driven from the field, that night the Libyans defected and fought the Greeks to find their way home. Agathocles slipped back to Syracuse and abandoned his army (ala Napoleon in Egypt). He never again would seriously threaten Carthage." - taken from GBoH Tyrant module, copyright GMT Games.
